Thank you for your email of 10 July 2025, requesting the following information from Unitec | Te Pūkenga – New Zealand Institute of Skills and Technology (Unitec):

Could you please tell me the total number of students enrolled in the Bachelor of Design and Contemporary Art programme at Unitec's Mt Albert campus in Semester 1 this year (2025)

If available, I would appreciate also knowing how many students were enrolled in the Bachelor of Design and Contempory [sic] Art programm [sic] at Unitec's Mt Albert campus in 2024 as well.

- Semester (e.g. Semester 1 and Semester 2)
- Full-time and part-time students

This letter provides a formal decision on your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA).

The decision

The total number of ākonga (students) enrolled in the Bachelor of Design and Contemporary Art at Unitec's Mt Albert campus in 2025 semester one was 67. The total number of ākonga enrolled across calendar year 2024 was 76 (made up of 65 total from semester one with an additional 11 joining in semester two).

The further breakdown you have requested is provided in the table below, including ākonga enrolled in semesters one and two, and full and part-time in each semester. We have also included the total by headcount.
